Welcome to St. Mary School!

This packet contains all the registration information needed for all students.

REQUIRED INFORMATION:

NEW STUDENTS:

1. Copy of the child's birth certificate.
2. Copy of the child's baptismal certificate.
3. Copy of the child's health records ("New Student Medical & Immunization Record" **must** be filled out by your physician prior to your child's first day of school)
4. Complete Permanent Record Card form
5. Complete St. Mary's School Contract
6. Complete Registration Information Form
7. Registration Fee
8. Emergency Contact Sheet (1) per student
9. Transportation Form – if applicable
10. Transfer Record

RETURNING STUDENTS:

1. Complete Registration Information Form
2. Registration Fee
3. \$10.00 PTA Dues per family
4. Emergency Contact Sheet (1) per student (September)
5. Health Records Update

IMPORTANT: Continued enrollment in any given school year, and re-enrollment in any subsequent years, is subject to the parent's or guardian's continued support of the mission of the school as documented in the school handbook and the maintenance of a demonstrably effective and supportive relationship between the school and the parents/guardian. Re-enrollment in any subsequent year is subject to mutual agreement. The parents or the school administration may withhold this agreement.

TUITION

KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 8 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR

St. Mary's School tuition for Kindergarten through Grade Eight will be as follows:

\$3,650	First child
\$2,800	2nd child
\$2,200	3rd child
\$2,200	4 th child

Note: Technology Fee \$75.00 per child will be added to tuition payment collected monthly through SMART, or pay in full by August 31, 2010. A family cap of \$250.00 applies to families with more than 3 children.

****Non-Catholic Fee is per child.**

1. Full payment of tuition by August 31, 2010. This payment should be made directly to the school and entitles you to a 1% tuition discount.
2. 10 automatic payments through the SMART Tuition Payment Plan. Payments will begin in July. You will have the option of payments being processed on the 5th or 20th of each month. There is a \$38 per year processing fee from SMART. If you prefer to pay your tuition bi-weekly (twice a month, the 5th and the 20th) you must complete 2 agreements. The second SMART account will be an additional \$38.00. The bank account must be the same.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

All students in grades Kindergarten through 8th grade are required to wear the approved school uniform and the approved gym uniform on gym day.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS & GYM UNIFORMS must be purchased from:

Your child's name should be written on sweaters, lunch boxes, school bags, jackets, gym suits – especially sweatshirts.

BOYS WINTER UNIFORM

- White shirt (short or long sleeve)
- Navy blue tie
- Navy blue dress pants (no dress jeans or Corduroys)
- Navy blue V-neck long sleeve school monogram sweater (pullover style)
- Black tie shoes (soft soles)
- Kindergarten through 2nd grade may wear golf shirts all year round.

BOYS SUMMER UNIFORM may be worn from the beginning of school to October 15th & April 15th to the end of school.

- Navy blue uniform shorts & belt
- White knit shirt with school logo
- White** sneakers
- White crew socks--above the ankle

GIRLS WINTER UNIFORM

- White blouse (short or long sleeve) with Peter Pan collar
- Jumper
- Navy blue knee socks
- Navy blue V-neck long sleeve school monogram sweater (pullover style)
- Saddle shoes (white with black or all navy blue)

Please note: Starting September 6, 2006, "Mary Jane's" (Velcro strapped) will not be an approved uniform shoe.

GIRLS SUMMER UNIFORM may be worn from the beginning of school to October 15th & April 15th to the end of school.

- Navy blue uniform shorts & belt
- White knit shirt with school logo
- White** sneakers
- White crew socks--above the ankle

Please note the following uniform requirement:

All uniform shirts must be tucked into pants or shorts. Girls and boys must wear belts. For summer uniforms, if you do not wear white sneakers, you must wear school shoes. Keds makes white sneakers for boys and girls. No open back sneakers allowed.

Backpacks with wheels are prohibited due to numerous accidents. The length of jumpers and skirts must reach the bend in the back of the knee. Please keep this in mind when ordering uniforms.

There will be a uniform check daily--three infractions warrant a detention.

EMERGENCY SCHOOL CLOSING INFORMATION

St. Mary School emergency school number is #730. If #730 has a delayed opening, St. Mary School will start at 10:00 am. There are several ways to find out if St. Mary School is closed or has a 2-hour delay:
